In 1996, Secretary of State Elaine F. Marshall became the first woman ever elected to a statewide, executive branch office in North Carolina. Secretary Marshall has been very active in many civic groups in the areas of child welfare, women's issues, and agriculture and small town economic development. Since becoming Secretary of State, she has received numerous state and national awards for leadership in technology, government innovation, and women's leadership.



Kimberly Bassett, Secretary of the District of Columbia

Kimberly A. Bassett was appointed to serve as the Secretary of the District of Columbia by Mayor Muriel Bowser on December 11, 2018. Ms. Bassett was the former Director of the Mayor's Office on Women's Policy and Initiatives (MOWPI) during Mayor Muriel Bowser's first term.
